

603/7811/6 ProQual Level 1 Award in Basic Construction Skills - Groundworks

Candidates will be assessed on their skills, knowledge and competence to achieve the qualification.

Type of validation: Qualification

Validation Passport Requirements

To demonstrate competence in groundwork skills the candidate must be visually recorded by their Assessor, whilst undertaking all of the following elements:

1. Introduction to Construction and Site Safety
 - a. Professional discussion to confirm candidate's knowledge of the following:
 - the importance of health and safety on construction sites
 - potential risks and hazards on construction sites
 - emergency and accident procedures on construction sites
2. Levelling Skills
 - a. transferring levels
3. Operating a petrol driven saw
 - a. undertaking a specified task
4. Concreting Skills
 - a. mix, lay, compact and finish concrete
5. Drainage Skills
 - a. prepare excavation to lay drainage
6. Kerblaying Skills
 - a. lay a kerb to line and level
7. Ride on roller
 - a. drive and manoeuvre the machine
8. Forward tipping dumber
 - a. drive and manoeuvre the machine

The Assessor must upload:

1. the visual evidence as listed above, plus
2. a copy of the candidate's qualification certificate to the SVS system for validation.

Following validation checks by SVS and payment of outstanding invoices the candidate's Validation Passport will be updated to reflect their validated competence.

Recording requirements

- a. each recorded element must include the individual stating their name and the qualification title
- b. each recording must not exceed 3 minutes; for this qualification the requirement is 8 recordings uploaded to SVS by the individual's Assessor
- c. recordings must be in the correct formats - formats are listed on your svsgateway.com platform
- d. it is the responsibility of the individual's Assessor to ensure that all validation requirements are met
